2009 pretty horses rosé

Low cropping, hand-picked, hillside Pinot Noir grapes have been crafted into a complex and expressive Rosé.

This wine exhibits vibrant aromas of strawberry and raspberry, while the creamy rich palate of berry-fruit reveals a style of Rosé with complexity, freshness and a long, lingering finish.

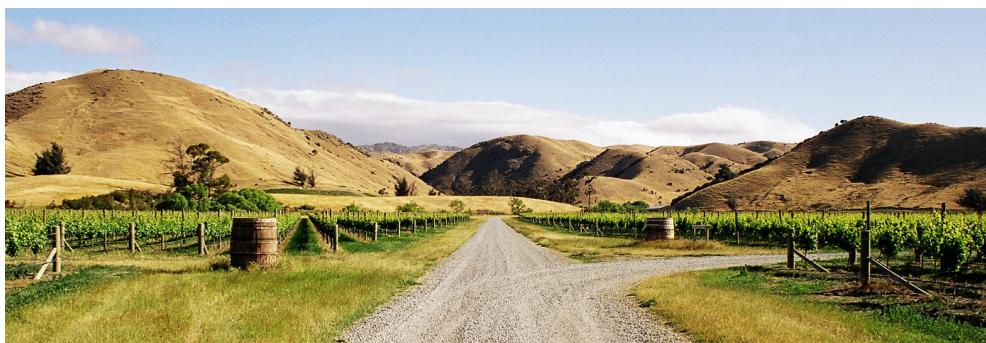
The “Pretty Horses”, Punch & Fan, were two of the magnificent Clydesdales that worked the land at Auntsfield Estate in colonial times.

Colour Ruby / Pink

Aroma Intense aromas of cherry, strawberry and raspberry liquorice are complemented by aromas of vanilla and dried spice.

Palate Rich, elegant and vibrant, this wine displays complex red berry fruit flavours layered within a creamy texture. The rich mouth feel is balanced by fresh fruit vibrancy and ends with a long lingering finish.
